

neither he nor his brother, Dr. John Contee Fairfax, ever claimed the title. Dr. Fairfax, a graduate of Princeton University and the University of Pennsylvania Medical School, married Mary Kirby, a daughter of Col. Edward Kirby, who served with distinction in the Mexican War, and a granddaughter of Ephriam Kirby, who founded the first law school in Connecticut, at Litchfield.

Their son, Albert Kirby Fairfax, was the first member of the family to make formal claim to the title for more than a century.

Baron Fairfax's sister, Mary C. Fairfax, was head mistress of the Chapin School in New York at the time of her death in 1935.
